

Club Reorganization

August

1. Select or elect new club leaders.
2. Invite prospective members to September meeting.

September

1. Elect club officers and county council representatives.
2. Appoint committees - every member should serve on a committee and each committee should have an adult advisor
3. Club leaders and members select projects to offer.
4. Recruit project leaders.
5. Club decides goals and club activity; reviews club standards and choose one to work toward.
6. 4-H Member Enrollment Forms (Y630) should be filled out for new members. Re-enrollment forms should be revised for returning members.
7. Missouri 4-H Volunteer Enrollment Form (LG636) must be filled out for new leaders - make sure form is signed.

October

1. Committees should meet. Program should be planned (from Nov. to Oct.)
2. Train officers (attend county or regional training.)
3. Install officers and initiate new members.
4. Return re-enrollment forms to the Extension Center with the \$8 state dues per member NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 31.
5. Committees report to club.
6. Read 4-H Council Constitution and Bylaws at club meeting.

November

1. Return new member and leader enrollment forms to the Extension Center with the \$8 state dues per member NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 30.
2. Program books are distributed to each family and one to the Extension Center.
3. Distribute handbooks to project leaders.
4. Start all projects.
