4-H Citizenship Washington Focus (CWF) June 22-July 1, 2019

This is a week-long summer program in Washington, DC where high school students learn about government and citizenship. Youth get a chance to see George Washington's home of Mount Vernon, Arlington National Cemetery, many of the memorials located in Washington, D.C., as well as all of the Smithsonian Museums. The groups will stay at the National 4-H Youth Conference Center in Chevy Chase, MD and will also take advantage of being in the nation's Capital to meet with senators and representatives on Capitol Hill! After leaving Washington D.C., the 4-H group will travel to Baltimore and New York for more exploring.

A statewide delegation of teens and chaperones from Missouri attend CWF every other summer. The Summer 2019 trip will include one group of approximately 35 youth ages 15-19, traveling together with the 4-H trip coordinator and chaperones. Estimated trip cost will be \$2,000 per youth, paid in four installments over several months. Price includes all lodging, meals, transportation, all entry prices to tour sights and meals while traveling.
