Teen 4-H'ers ages 15-18 (as of 12-31-17) who would like to work with younger 4-H'ers may apply to serve as Camp Counselors by requesting an application and completing the attached form by May 1. Those selected to serve as Counselors will receive a full or half fee refund. **ALL** 4-H'ers will pay the full camp fee at time of registration and refunds will be made following camp. Youth who are age 14 are eligible to apply as a counselor in training. Counselor Training will be June 12 at a location to be determined from 4:00-8:00 p.m. All counselors are expected to attend.



Camp Location

Our 4-H camp will be held at Pinecrest Camp and Retreat Center south of Fredericktown. It is about 40 miles from Perryville. Find more information about the wonderful camp site at: www.pinecrestcamp.org We are camping together this year with 4-H members from Cape Girardeau, Scott, Ste. Genevieve, and St. Francois counties.

What do I Need to Bring to Camp?

- Blanket and sheet or sleeping bag/pillow
- Clothing for 2 hot days and 1 cool night (NO spaghetti straps, tube tops or halter tops)
- Swim suit/towels
- Personal grooming items
- Sun screen
- Flashlight
- Lotion bug repellent.

ALL shoes must be closed-toe!

Leave valuables at home.
