- Ribbons will be given to top the 5 places in each class.
- High point and Reserve High Point awards will be given in the following categories: Walk-Trot, 13 and under, and 14 and over.
- Points earned in an “All ages” class will count towards your High Point category.
- Walk-trot riders may not enter classes that lope. You must have 2 years or less experience.

Properly fitted ASTM and SEI certified helmets will be required for all speed events. A rider will be disqualified if the helmet is not on the exhibitor’s head and fastened for the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena.
