Who: Current or former Platte County 4-Hers who has been a member for at least four (4) years. Must be enrolled in post-secondary education or training. Grades must be C or higher average. Applicants must be between 17 and 22 years of age. Award: \$250 OR \$500. Special application due April 1. Recipients will have their name engraved on a plaque at the 4-H Office.
