Extension personnel and grape growers will be on hand to provide information on growing grapes in Missouri, including how to grow premium grapes, grapes that wineries are buying, best vineyard practices, and more . Participants will hear from a producer who grows grapes for the wholesale market. After the workshop, participants are invited to visit Jubilee Vineyard to get first-hand knowledge about what producers are doing in the vineyard in July.
