Junior's will participate in a judging workshop, judge 6-8 classes, and provide reasons for 1 class.

Senior Division - youth 14-18 years old (as of Jan 1)

Seniors will judge 6-8 classes and provide reasons for 2 classes.

**Traveling into Mexico on Hwy 15 or Hwy 22**

Continue on Hwy 15 to Boulevard (road will T). Turn Left on to Boulevard. At the next stop light turn Right on to Clark Street. Continue on Clark St., pass Sydenstricker's John Deere. Turn Right onto Hwy D (towards Country Hearth Inn). The 4-H Center will be about ½ mile on the right (north) side of road.

**Traveling Hwy 54**

Arriving in Mexico, take the first exit, Business 54, Hwy22 & 15 Exit (towards Wal-Mart). Almost immediately after you cross the overpass you will turn left on to Hwy D (towards Country Hearth Inn). If you pass Wal-Mart you've gone too far. The 4-H Center will be about ½ mile on the right (north) side of road.
