

## Medical Information for Parents

There will be a nurse at camp the entire three day period.

All prescription medications and over-the-counter medications are collected and administered by the camp nurse and **MUST** be in original bottles with labels and dispensing instructions. Any requiring injections should provide medications, syringes, and written instructions signed by physicians. Please send written instructions with any over-the-counter medication sent with the child if the treatment differs from the label.

Camp will have certain basic over-the-counter medications. The majority of children seen by the nurse require no more than basic first aid or treatment which you provide for your child at home. Common problems the children complain of are headaches and stomachaches. Listed below are medications that will be stocked in the camp nurses station:
