

Uploading photos to Facebook



Choose photo or album

When uploading photos to Facebook, you are given the choice of uploading a single photo, a group of photos for a post or creating an album.


Upload photos by choosing **Add Photo** or **Create Album** from the menu options next to **Update Status** on your timeline. You can also add photos under the **Photos** tab on your profile page by clicking either the **Create Album** or **Add Photos** buttons.

If you are uploading one, two or a few photos, choose **Add photo**. The interface lets you choose multiple photos from your computer.



If your photos are all related to a single topic or event, you can group them in an arrangement by choosing **Create Photo Album** from the menu option or under the **Photos** tab on your profile page, click **Create Album** button.

A browser window pops up for you to select the images from your computer. Navigate to the folder with your images, and choose the ones to upload. Click **Open**. The images are put into an album on Facebook. You can create a title, description and location for the album. You can also caption and tag all of the photos within the album.



Sharing an album

You can allow others to contribute to the album by making it a shared album. When you have created your album, a dialog box will ask you if you want to share the album. Click **Change to Shared Album** and click **Okay** if you want to share the album.
