

GENERAL INFORMATION

The grounds will be open for reception of exhibits at the times specified by each department. Department Superintendents will assign display space. Any animal eligible for show in this Fair must be owned by the exhibitor. Each livestock exhibitor must furnish his own feed and feed trough.

Each exhibitor or Fair attendee is expected to deal fairly and politely with others and the Fair Board reserves the right to remove violators from the fairgrounds.

All exhibitors will remain in place until released by the Superintendent of the department. The exhibitor will be responsible for all livestock and have a competent attendant in charge at all times. Advance entry required for all livestock, poultry and rabbits for both Open and Junior Division.

Exhibitors must fill out the enclosed entry blank for beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, poultry, rabbits, and hogs in the open classes and all classes in the Junior Division. **Entries may be mailed to Jim Howard, 1435 Schwartz Lane, Farmington, MO 63640 no later than Friday, July 24th, prior to start of Fair. Youth entries must be mailed to Jim Howard by July 15th. Enclose payment to the St. Francois County Fair Association for all fees and season passes.** Poultry and rabbit entries should be sent to the Show Chairman.

ADMISSION: Begins daily at 8 a.m. The low price of admission to the St. Francois County Fair made possible by the "Everybody Pays" policy. Persons not holding season passes entering the grounds must pay the daily admission fee. This applies to officials of the fair, employees, exhibitors, judges, performers, concessionaires and fair visitors.

GENERAL ADMISSION: FREE Tues, \$5.00 Wed., \$6.00 Thurs., Fri. & Sat.

SEASON PASS: \$15.00; Season passes available at First State Community Bank – Bonne Terre; Miller Feed & Pet in Farmington; University of MO Extension Center or any Fair Board member.

PASSES: All deliveries must be made before 10 a.m. and vehicle must be taken outside the fence before that time unless a vehicle parking permit is purchased and displayed in the vehicle.
