



# St. Francois County 4-H & FFA Market Broiler Exhibitor Checklist 2019



## General Information about the Boiler Project

- Exhibitor must supply cage for judging and will be sold as part of broiler project.
- Broiler pen will consist of 3 birds
- Birds must be 5-6 weeks old at judging.
  - Pullets will potentially develop better
  - A Cornish Cross would be an ideal bird because of muscle development in a short time period
  - If you need help obtaining chicks you can check with Stover Hatchery, or Estes Hatchery.
- 4-H and FFA exhibitors will maintain responsibility of their cage of exhibits while at the county fair. Please check with superintendent for feeding and watering instructions during the fair.
- Exhibitor must supply cage. Buyer will be purchasing cage along with 3 animals.
  - Each seller is responsible to be at the sale to carry their cage into the ring. If they are unable to carry the cage, they will arrange for another participant to assist.

## Pre Show Checklist

- Meet membership requirements for St. Francois County 4-H and or FFA
  - St. Francois County 4-H membership requirements
    - Be in good standing with your 4-H Club
    - Be a paid member
    - Attend a majority of club meetings
- Attend the mandatory SFC Youth Livestock Seminar - March 15.
  - If 4-H exhibitor can not attend they must complete the 4-H Project Book
- Complete SMQA (Show Me Quality Assurance Program)
  - Course available online at: <http://agebb.missouri.edu/smqa/index.htm>
- Each 4-H member participating in the St. Francois County Fair must complete 2 hours of volunteer service at the fairground to be eligible to participate in the Sale of Champions.
  - Dates will be advertised at a later date
  - Once service hours are completed, please fill out the attached youth member volunteer form, and return with Exhibitor and Buyer Book Information Sheet.
- Exhibitor and Buyer Book Information Sheet
  - Return the completed form by July 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Include the \$10 advertising fee for each animal being sold
- Enter your animal with the St. Francois County Fairboard by deadline
  - Entry forms will be available in 2019 St. Francois County Fairbook
  - Online at: <http://www.stfrancoiscountyfair.com>
  - Each species must use a separate entry form
- Attend the mandatory exhibitors meeting July 20
  - Turn in exhibit form
  - Turn in project books if did not attend the March 15th Youth Livestock Seminar
