

Supreme Beef Female Purple Ribbon Sale

To be eligible for the Supreme Beef Female award the youth must:

1. Be a member in good standing of 4-H or FFA in St. Francois County.
2. Nominate animal using form below.
3. Exhibit their animal(s) at the St. Francois County Prospect Steer & Heifer Show.
4. Complete the SMQA program.
5. Enter their animal with the St. Francois County Fair
6. Attend the required exhibitor meeting OR complete Beef Project Book
7. Complete and turn in Project Record Form & Financial Record (turned in prior to receiving sale of champions check)
8. If the title of Supreme Beef Female is won, pay a \$10.00 advertising fee.

Exhibitors may nominate two beef females by April 10 via the form below. The heifers must also attend and be shown at the St. Francois County 4-H and FFA Prospect show to be eligible for the St. Francois County Sale of Champions. The animal must be identified by ear tag or tattoo and will be verified at the St. Francois County Prospect Show. If an excused absence is permitted from the show, the individual must send identifying pictures with ear tag or tattoo to the St. Francois County Extension Office by April 15, 2019. Participants in the Sale of Champions can only sell a maximum of two items (Supreme Beef Female Ribbon counts as one item), unless they show both the Grand Champion and Reserve champion animals in which case they may sell both*

The Supreme Beef Female Ribbon will be sold after the Reserve Champion Steer.
Beef Females must be in place at the fairgrounds by time indicated in the fairbook.

*Exhibitors may sell a maximum of 2 items in the Junior Division Auction, unless all items sold are grand champions or reserve champions. **Youth are responsible for the care of their animal until it is released on Sunday.**

The Supreme Beef Female will be selected during the St. Francois County Fair junior show. She will be selected as an overall top female of all breeds. If the Supreme Beef female was not exhibited at the St. Francois County 4-H & FFA Prospect Show, or if the exhibitor is a non St. Francois County exhibitor, the ribbon is ineligible to sell, the next highest placing beef female who was exhibited at the Prospect Show will be eligible to sell their purple ribbon. The top exhibitor of the Supreme Beef Female will receive the junior fair award even if animal was not show at the Prospect Show.
