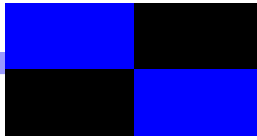


Mackley

The Mackley Memorial Fund was created to remember James David Mackley (1965-1988) and Jeremy Willard Mackley (1984-1996).

Both boys loved agriculture and this scholarship will help another young person pursue a career in agriculture.

The St. Francois County Extension Council will administer the scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded to a deserving person who is going to pursue a degree in an agriculture related field.

The student can attend a 2 or 4 year college and technical school.

Preference will be given to students who have been active in 4-H and FFA in that order. Other Ag students may be considered.

Monies will be paid out to the school directly when the council receives proof of enrollment.

The scholarship amount will depend on interest earnings in the last year up to \$500. The award will reflect the strength of the account balance and may be adjusted as is fiscally responsible.

Applications are due by June 26, 2017 to the Extension Office.

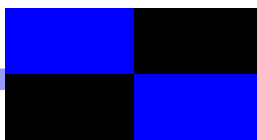
The award will be given at the St. Francois County Fair.
