Grab your hot dogs, nachos, peanuts, and other snacks and head on over to Busch Stadium because baseball season is not over yet! Garrett R. Broshuis, a Complex Litigation attorney with Korein Tillery's St. Louis office, knows all too well the ins and outs of the game. He has represented dozens of former minor league baseball players in a wage-and-hour action, challenging the pay scheme for minor leaguers, and is involved in nascent efforts by minor leaguers to organize (they currently have no union). His work has been featured on HBO's Real Sports with Bryant Gumbel, NPR's "All Things Considered," MSNBC, and many other major outlets. Come and meet Garrett at our November 14 Labor Law Breakfast as he brings a unique position to talk about America's Pastime from the vantage point of the worker.

In addition to his work with Korein Tillery, Garrett is an adjunct professor of sports law at Saint Louis University. During his undergraduate career at the University of Missouri, Garrett earned both All-American and Academic All-American honors for NCAA Division-I baseball. In 2004, he became a finalist for the Big 12 Conference Male Athlete of the Year after recording a perfect 11-0 record as a pitcher. He also earned the school's Total Person Program Excellence Award three times.

The San Francisco Giants drafted Garrett in the fifth round of the 2004 amateur baseball draft. He played at all levels of minor league baseball during his six-year career with the Giants and attained the second most wins of any pitcher in the entire organization from 2008 to 2009. For four years, he wrote a regular column for two sports magazines, *The Sporting News* and *Baseball America*.
