

# Chlorothalonils

- Not absorbed into leaf
- Provide control by limiting infection and spore germination on leaf surface
- 7 to 14 day re-spray interval, depending on rainfall
- Products such as Echo, Bravo WeatherStik



# Strobilurons

- Longer residual than triazoles
- Move slower through leaf tissue
- Limit spore germination & fungal growth
- Not as effective at controlling established infections
- Products such as Headline, Quadris



# Triazoles

- “sterol inhibitors”
- Short residual periods
- Move rapidly through leaf
- High rates required for residual control past 14 days (otherwise, may be dissipated from plant tissue)
- Products such as Domark, Folicur, Tilt, Laredo
