

REQUIREMENT FORM

To show/exhibit at the Warren County Fair:

A 4-H member must have attended 7 club meetings and 2/3 of project meetings by fairtime.

To participate in State Events: (includes shooting sports, livestock judging, public speaking, fashion revue, horse judging, dairy, forestry, meats, poultry, wildlife, horse bowl & hippology):

Participation in state events and certain county events is limited to those members who are in "good standing" with their local 4-H club. This includes submission of enrollment forms on or before county deadlines for a given year, attendance at a majority of project and club meetings prior to the event, and meeting other requirements established by the club, county and/or state.

Requirements to complete the 4-H year:

1. Attend a majority of monthly club meetings (1 over half). In the event a member can't meet this requirement, special consideration is given to members with conflicting school activities or employment provided they give written notice to the club leader in advance. In which case, the 4-H member may make up a missed club meeting by volunteering to do extra activities for the club or county.
2. Attend a majority of project meetings and finish at least one project in which enrolled. A project is defined as a separate listing in the Clover. The project completion is verified by the project leader or club leader.
