Each cow shown at the 2011 Wayne County Fair must be pre-registered by August 1, 2011. If cow is not Pre-Registered, it will NOT show. There will be NO exceptions.

All cattle must be checked-in by 9:00 am on Saturday Sept. 24, 2011. Judging starts at 3:00 pm.

All cattle must be checked-out by 8:00 pm on Saturday Sept. 24, 2011, unless in 4-H sale on Sunday.

Must be a 4-H member in order to sell livestock in sale on Sunday Sept. 25, 2011

There will be a \$5.00 entry fee. Only one cow per form please.

1. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection/General Requirements

A. All animals must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection shall state that the animals are free of visible signs of contagious, infectious, or communicable disease, describe the animal(s) by species, breed, sex and age. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection shall reflect all data for required test and vaccinations, all dates, results and the name of the laboratory.

B. Animals with active lesions of ringworm or warts will not be permitted to exhibit and shall be subject to isolation and expulsion.

2. Exhibition requirements for Cattle in Missouri.

A. Intrastate (cattle in Missouri moving for Exhibition only).

1. No Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required.
2. Brucellosis - no test or vaccination is required.
3. Tuberculosis - no test is required.

B Interstate (cattle from another state moving into Missouri for exhibition only).

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with official individual identification for each animal listed.
2. Brucellosis.

A. Cattle from Brucellosis-Free States.

1. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection required with official individual identification for each animal listed.
2. All cattle may enter without a brucellosis test.
3. Steer(s). No test required but the steer(s) must be individually identified and listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

B. Sexually intact cattle from brucellosis Class A states. All test-eligible animals must be tested and negative within thirty (30) days prior to entry except cattle from a certified brucellosis-free herd. The certified herd number and the date of the last herd test must be shown on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection; and.

3. Tuberculosis.

A. Beef - all beef cattle two (2) months of age and older (include steers) that originate from a state having a tuberculosis status less than free must meet the following requirements:

1. Must obtain an entry permit.
2. Have a negative tuberculosis test within sixty (60) days of shipment; test date must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection; or
3. Move from an accredited tuberculosis-free herd (herd test date must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection); or

4. Move directly from a herd of origin that has had one (1) complete negative herd test within one (1) year (date of test must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection).
