Cody Bellinger Outstanding New Club Member Award Criteria

To be awarded to an outstanding new club member who is nominated by their club leader based on the following list of criteria.

- 1. Must be a new member who is enrolled in the current project year. May also be a former member who has re-enrolled after a period of inactivity for a year or more.
- 2. Must attend the majority of club meetings after their enrollment date.
- 3. Must attend as many club activities and participate in as many club fundraisers as they can.
- 4. Show initiative, be willing to help or take on leadership roles, such as committee work, activity planning etc.
- 5. Attend the majority of project meetings offered in their enrolled project(s).
- 6. Complete the year as outlined by the Adair County 4-H Council By-Laws.
- 7. The current club leader will nominate their candidate by submitting the appropriate form provided. Leaders may nominate up to two new members. However only one award will be given unless there is a tie.
