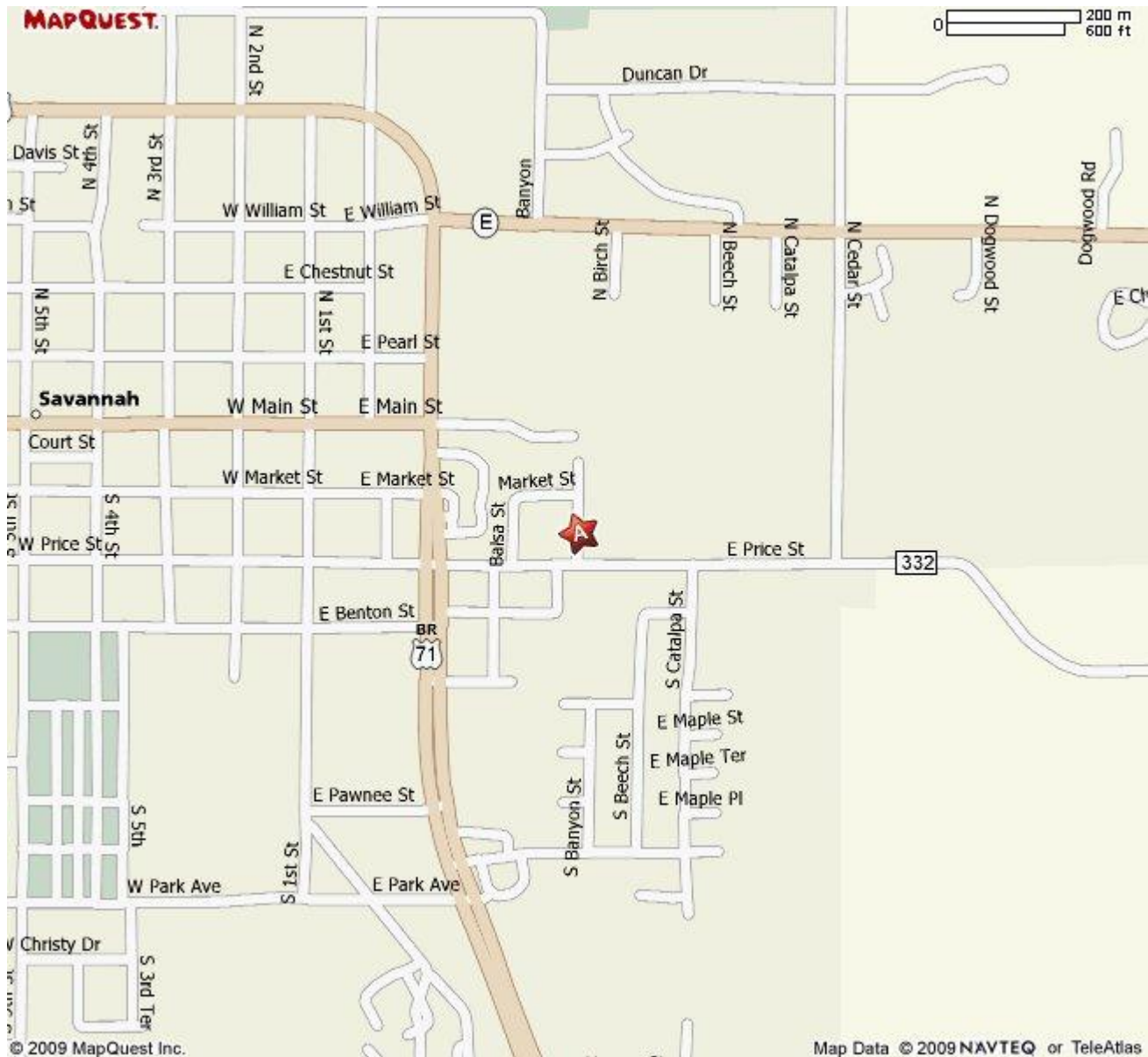

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## 2025 LIVESTOCK RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All livestock shows are open to youth 8-21 years of age as of January 1, 2025. Pee Wee: Birth to 7 years of age.
2. Each exhibitor will be given a T-Shirt during registration. T-Shirt MUST be worn during the respective shows.
3. TO ESTABLISH A BREED DIVISION, THERE MUST BE AT LEAST TWO (2) EXHIBITORS OR FIVE (5) OR MORE ANIMALS. Otherwise, they will be shown in the "Other" class.
4. An entry may only be shown in breeding class or market class, not both.
5. Limit of three (3) market animals per exhibitor. Limit of two (2) animals per exhibitor per breeding class.
6. Show Fee: Please refer to individual show pages for fees.
7. All breeds and crosses will show together in market classes. The Superintendent will divide the class by size/weight, or where warranted, by number of entries.
8. See individual livestock pages for times of registration and show, as well as classes.
9. Exhibits must meet Missouri Department of Agriculture Health requirements. Visit <https://agriculture.mo.gov/animals/pdf/livestock-requirements.pdf>
10. **MDA Exhibition Rules for Poultry** visit <https://agriculture.mo.gov/animals/pdf/exhib-req-poultry.pdf>
11. Wood shavings are permitted in pen area.
12. The management assumes **NO** responsibility for loss or damage. However, all due precautions will be taken to ensure safety. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL.** If you cannot keep animals under control and there is danger to spectators or other exhibitors, the superintendent may excuse exhibitor from show ring.
13. **ANY BEEF SHOWING EVIDENCE OF WARTS AND RINGWORM WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW.** A certified veterinarian will make final judgment.
14. **ANY LAMBS THAT SHOW EVIDENCE OF LIVE FUNGUS (BLEEDING OR WAXY) ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.**
15. All questions will be resolved by the Superintendents and the committee of their choice.
16. The Andrew County Livestock is composed of volunteers from surrounding communities. Please see a complete list of all members.
17. The livestock superintendents have the right to change rules at their discretion as needed for the benefit of all.
18. **NO CROSS ENTERING IN AGE DIVISIONS, YOU MAY ONLY SHOW IN YOUR CORRECT AGE DIVISION.**
19. *No straw is allowed on the grounds. Hay, sawdust, and shavings are permitted.*
20. **Failure to comply with the above rules may lead to dismissal from the premises.**

The individuals in charge of each event will follow the above rules.

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## Missouri Exhibition Requirements for Poultry

### Specific Requirements for Poultry

1. **Intrastate** (poultry in Missouri moving within Missouri for exhibition only)

- a. No Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required.
- b. All poultry and waterfowl to be exhibited must be free of clinical signs of any infectious or contagious disease.
- c. Pullorum-Typhoid test. All poultry (except Missouri origin waterfowl) exhibited shall be tested negative for pullorum-typhoid within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition, or originate from a flock approved by the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP), or an equivalent program, which has been tested within the past twelve (12) months with no change of ownership. This information shall be documented on a VS Form 9-2 (see 2 CSR 30-8.020) or similar certificate which shall accompany the poultry to the exhibition and shall be made available on request.

2. **Interstate** (poultry entering Missouri for exhibition only)

- a. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, VS Form 9-2 or similar certificate is required.
- b. An entry permit is required.
- c. All poultry and waterfowl to be exhibited must be free of clinical signs of any infectious or contagious disease.
- d. Pullorum-typhoid test. All poultry exhibited shall be tested negative for pullorum-typhoid within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition or originate from a flock approved by the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) or an equivalent program in which the flock has been tested within the past twelve (12) months with no change of ownership. This information shall be documented on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, a VS Form 9-2 (see 2 CSR 30-8.020) or similar certificate which shall accompany the poultry to exhibition and shall be made available on request.

3. Requirements for Sponsoring Exhibitions for Poultry.

- a. An official representing the person or organization sponsoring the exhibition shall notify the state veterinarian no later than thirty (30) days prior to the exhibition giving the names, place, inclusive dates and times of event.
- b. Record Keeping. The sponsor of the exhibition shall compile a list of all poultry present at the exhibition. The list shall contain the name and address of each owner, the number, species, breed, variety, type, sex, and pullorum-typhoid status of all poultry present. A copy of this list shall be retained by the sponsor of the exhibition for at least twelve (12) months and shall be made available upon request to a representative of the department.
- c. Inspection. Poultry must be free of clinical signs of an infectious or contagious disease. Any poultry showing signs of infectious or contagious disease at an exhibition may be excused by the official inspecting veterinarian or department representative.

# LIVESTOCK EXHIBITION RULES

**\*COMING 2025**

The Missouri Department of Agriculture is implementing new animal health requirements for cattle and swine exhibitors at fairs and exhibitions in Missouri for 2025. MDA is taking a proactive step toward disease prevention and traceability.

## Whats New?

Cattle and swine exhibitors must provide a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), completed by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of the show.

- A printed or an electronic version of the CVI is acceptable.
- Ensure all the shows where you intend to exhibit within Missouri over the 30-day period are listed on one CVI.
- Cattle and swine projects must be identified with an official form of identification.

## Official Identification

*USDA-APHIS recently amended its animal disease traceability regulations. The new rule requires official eartags to be visually and electronically readable for use in interstate movement. The final rule applies to **all sexually intact cattle and bison 18 months of age or older, all dairy cattle, cattle and bison of any age used for rodeo or recreation events, and cattle or bison of any age used for shows or exhibitions.** The rule went in to effect **Nov. 5, 2024.** NUES 9 tags are no longer acceptable forms of official identification for those animals affected by the rule. If your impacted animal was tagged with a NUES 9 tag before Nov. 5, there will be no penalty and the animal will not need a new tag.*

- An official National Uniform Eartagging System (NUES) tag (**SWINE ONLY**)
  - Begins with the official state number 43 for Missouri.
  - Allocated by USDA to accredited veterinarians.
- An official Animal Identification Number (AIN) tag
  - Consists of 15 digits, beginning with 840 for the United States.
  - Visual or Radio Frequency Identification (RFID).
  - Available directly from the manufacturer with proof of a [Premises Identification Number](#), or provided by an accredited veterinarian.
- A registration tattoo and registration papers from the appropriate breed association.

2024 will serve as an educational year for exhibitors and exhibition leadership to become accustomed to the new rules. See [Enforcement Discretion document](#).

- Animals showing in breed classes must have registration papers available as proof of ownership and birth date of animals; otherwise, they will be considered as crossbred.
- Out of state animals must have a Certified Veterinary Inspection within the last 30 days.
- No penning in wash racks – Pens are available for exhibitors – Exhibitor is responsible for set up and tear down.
- Purebred Boars and Gilts will be shown by date of birth.
- All Barrows and Crossbreds will be shown by weight.
- All Boars, Gilts, and Barrows will be broken out by breed – If only one animal in a breed, they will be placed in an OPB class.
- Breeds will be shown as follows: Berkshire, Chester White, Duroc, Hampshire, Hereford, Landrace, Poland China, Spot, Tamworth, Yorkshire, OPB if needed, Crossbred.
- Weights will be declared at check in.

- CROSSBRED RAMS, EWES and MARKET LAMBS will be shown by weight.

- Any breeding entry older than 18 months needs appropriate scrapies tag

- Date of Birth is required.
- Animals showing in breed classes must have registration papers, with corresponding ear tag or tattoo, available as proof of ownership and birth date of animals; otherwise, they will be considered as crossbred.
- Calves shown in Classes 1098 & 1099 will not be eligible to show in any other class. They must be shown without sticks. Judging will be based on knowledge (Show & Tell) of animal and ability to control animal.
- ANY BEEF SHOWING EVIDENCE OF WARTS AND RINGWORM WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW.
- Animals shown in breed classes cannot be shown in market class.
- Indicate breed when entering breeding animal classes: Angus, Hereford, Simmental, Charolais, Gelbvieh, etc.

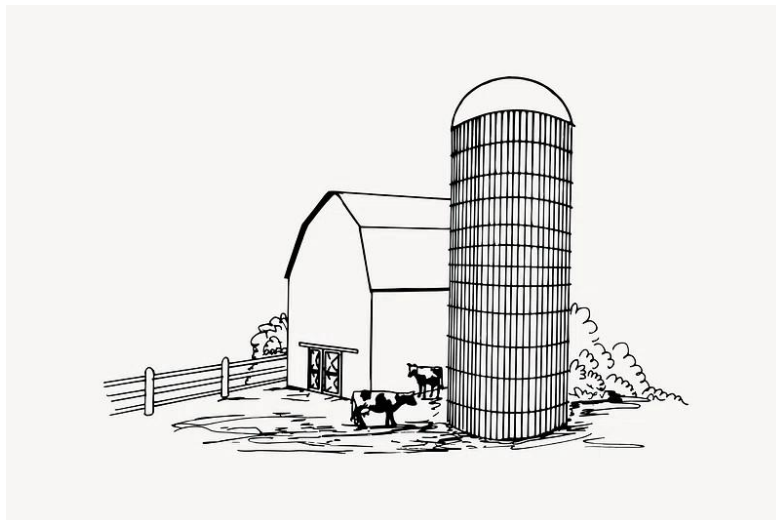
