Dear 4-H & FFA Fair Exhibitors,

Again this year, all 4-H and FFA exhibitors are required to submit a pre-entry form for livestock shows, ham/bacon entries, and 4-H building exhibits that you plan to participate in during the county fair. Entry Forms are due **Friday, June 14** to the Audrain County Extension Office.

LIVESTOCK SHOWS

With your entry form you will pay your entry fees and save money. Entries accepted after the **June 14** deadline will pay an increased fee. Substitutions will be allowed at the show. In the event that you do not bring one an animal you pre-entered and you do not substitute it, **you will not receive a refund**. Please try to be as accurate as you can so that show superintendents can plan classes and stall assignments accordingly.
