4-H Scrapbook Guidelines

A scrapbook tells the history of your club. It is fun to browse through a scrapbook and see the pictures, articles and read as the story unfolds. To accomplish this a scrapbook must be neat, organized and complete. Here is a guideline to help you put your book together.

Section 1, Cover page and pictures (5 points)

- 1. The cover page gives the name of the 4-H Club.
- 2. *Pictures of the 4-H Club leaders and assistants.
- 3. *Pictures of the project and activity leaders.
- 4. *Pictures of the club officers and committee chairmen.
- 5. *Pictures of the 4-H members (parents may also be included).

*These pictures may be single or group pictures. For member pictures you may have single or group also. An idea is to take pictures by year in 4-H for members. It's up to you.

Section 2, The month pages (36 points)

Prepare a page for each month of the 4-H year. Our year begins in September and ends in August. For each month include these:

- 1. Newspaper clippings about club meetings. If the paper did not print the story, write a summary for this page.
- 2. Pictures taken at the club meeting of speakers, events, demonstrations, or other things of interest.
- 3. Other newspaper clippings about your club or its members pertaining to 4-H that month.

Section 3, Special feature section (12 points)

This is a picture report of one (ONLY ONE) outstanding event or activity in which your club was involved. The pictures should each have a caption explaining what is happening. A written statement explaining how the event was done and why and what it achieved should be included in this section.

Section 4, Miscellaneous section (5 points)

There are always news clippings or pictures which could not be used in another section....use them here. However, make sure they are organized in some matter and labeled.

Section 5, Sources of news (2 points)

On a page include the masthead (the part of the newspaper which is the front and has the name of the paper) from which you obtained your clippings. Remember the 4-H newsletter is also a source.

Good luck. Remember the club is counting on this scrapbook to tell the whole story!!!!
