Bates County Fair Queen Rules

Rules:

1. Candidates must be a resident of Bates County.
2. Candidates must be single, never married and childless.
3. Candidates must be 14-21 years of age by July 4, 2019.
4. Candidates must pre-register by calling Whitney Bagby at 816-804-9940.
5. All candidates will receive informational packets at the pre-sale dinner for candidates and parents. Date and time to be announced.

6. Queen candidates shall be judged for the following:

Application	50 points
Public Questions/Answers	50 points
Fair Knowledge Test	25 points
Raffle/ Event Tickets	50 points

 Determined by 5 points for the first \$1,000 in sales; then 1 point per \$100 of sales.

7. Candidates are expected to ride in the Fair Parade, and attend a public interview at the bash following the parade.
8. Candidates shall receive:
 - 10% of the first 2,500 in ticket sales after a minimum of \$1,500 is sold.
 - 15% from 2,501 to \$3,999 in sales.
 - 20% above \$4,000. **NO MAXIMUM ON SALES!**
9. All money shall be turned in Saturday, July 13, 2019, by NOON!
10. All candidates are eligible for the special top sales award of \$100.
11. The Queen shall receive in addition to her sales percentage:

- *A one-time \$250 college scholarship.
- *Money to be given at the completion of first semester with presentation of grades.
- *Must maintain a 2.0 GPA.

12. Runner- up shall fulfill the duties of the queen is she is unable.
13. Coronation will be held Saturday evening.
14. Money will be awarded to Queen and Princess at the August fair board meeting.

1. Candidates must be a resident of Bates County.
2. Candidates must be single, never married and childless.
3. Candidates must be 9-13 years of age by July 4, 2019.
4. Candidates must pre-register by calling Whitney Bagby at 816-804-9940.
5. All candidates will receive informational packets at the pre-sale dinner for candidates and parents. Date and time to be announced.
6. Princess candidates shall be judged for the following:

Application	50 points
Interview (poise, personality, attributes)	50 points
Raffle Tickets/ Event tickets	50 points

Determined by 5 points for the first \$1,000 in sales; then 1 point per \$100 of sales.

7. Candidates are expected to ride in the Fair Parade.
8. Candidates shall receive:
 - 10% of the first 2,500 in ticket sales after a minimum of \$1,000 is sold.
 - 15% from 2,501 to \$3,999 in sales.
 - 20% above \$4,000. NO MAXIMUM ON SALES!
9. All money shall be turned in Saturday, July 13, 2019, by NOON!
10. All candidates are eligible for the special top sales award of \$50.
11. Coronation will be held Saturday evening.
12. Money will be awarded to Queen and Princess at the August fair board meeting.
