Teams visit a variety of facilities each month, including libraries, nursing homes, schools and other special events.

Participation in the program is a commitment. Therapy Teams are dogs that are at least one year old who, with their handler, pass a temperament evaluation, three months of probation visits and then graduate as a Registered Team. Re-evaluation is required every two years.
