Farm Service Agency Youth Loans

The Farm Service Agency makes loans to youth to establish and operate agricultural income-producing projects in connection with 4-H clubs, FFA and other agricultural groups. Projects must be planned and operated with the help of the organization advisor, produce sufficient income to repay the loan and provide the youth with practical business and educational experience. The maximum loan amount is \$5,000. Stop by the county FSA office for loan eligibility requirements, help preparing and processing the application forms.

Congressional Award

The Congressional Award recognizes youth for their community service, physical fitness, personal development (learning), and expedition (exploring or planning a trip). While this is a national award and not specific to 4-H, our 4-H youth are doing many things that are part of the award. Youth ages 13 to 24 can apply for the award. Youth need to register for the award before they can start counting their hours. They will need to keep track of their activities and amount of time spent doing them. After they have reached the criteria for bronze, silver or gold medals, they will complete the Record Book.
