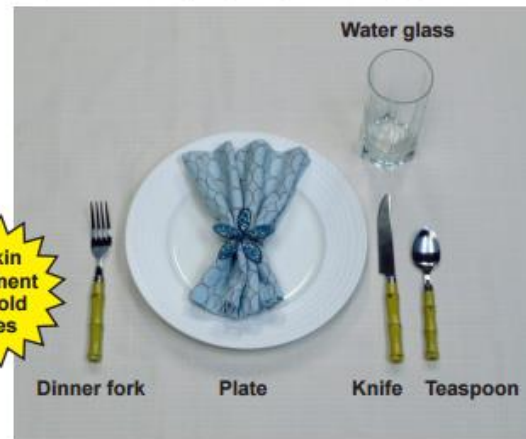
### FORMAL PLACE SETTING
