

End-of-year forms required to complete 4-H year

4-H members must complete a Participation and Project Record survey or form in order to complete the 4-H year. Members that had an animal project will also be required to fill out an Animal Project Record survey or form for their market animal, breeding animal and pet projects. Those who complete the year will receive a completion medal for the number of years they have completed. First year members will receive a first year pin, second year members will receive a second year pin, and so on. The Franklin County 4-H Rules that you signed when you enrolled specify the minimum requirements a member must meet in order to receive a completion medal. Among the requirements is the completion of at least one project, including the paper work.

New this year- you have the option of filling out your Project Participation and Animal Records through an online survey instead of the paper copy. Follow the links under the Member End of Year paperwork to take the survey online!

Special note for livestock project members:

Members, who were enrolled in a beef, sheep, or swine project this past year, must complete the paper work for the project in order to be eligible to sell at next year's Washington Town and Country Fair.

Special Note for Teens:

Teens must complete the paper work for the current 4-H year to be eligible to apply for a 4-H Camp Counselor position next spring.

The paper work is due to your club leader by **September 16.**
