- 1. Must submit copies of all articles written by the reporter and published concerning 4-H (newspaper, school paper, 4-H newsletter, etc.)
- 2. All articles are to be in a notebook and must have been printed in this 4-H year (October 1 September 30).
- 3. This application must be the first page in your folder and is available online or at the Extension Office.
- 4. You must be the elected Reporter of a Greene County 4-H Club or Teen Council.
- 5. The completed Reporter Award Application is due with all year end award applications. This is the same time that the super 4-H'er, reporter, treasurer book, secretary book and project medal awards are due.
- 6. The Reporter of the Year Award will be presented to the top three entries (a maximum of three winners) at the Greene County 4-H Recognition Night.
