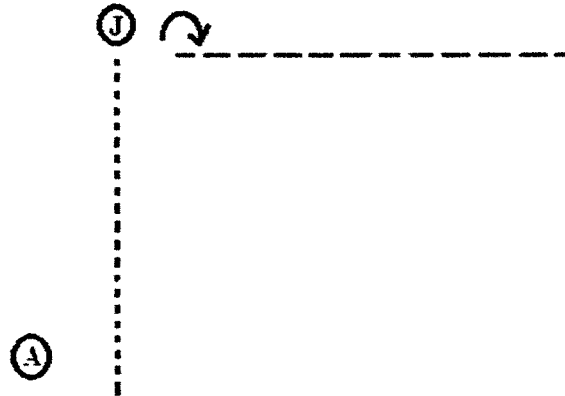


Jackson Co. 4H Levels Horse Show

Showmanship

Pattern #1



1. Be Ready At Cone A
2. Walk To Judge
3. Set Up For Inspection
4. When Dismissed Turn 90 deg. To The Right
5. Trot Away From Judge

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

Pattern #1

Expectations:

1. Exhibitor is expected to execute, in concert with a well-groomed and conditioned horse, a set of maneuvers with precision and smoothness, maintaining a balanced, functional and correct body position. Patterns are designed to test the showman's ability to present a horse to a judge.
2. Exhibitor's overall poise, confidence, appearance and body position and the physical appearance of the horse will be evaluated.
3. Exhibitor should quickly correct faults in the positioning of the horse and avoid excessive, unnatural or animated body positions.
4. Exhibitor's hand should not be on the snap or chain portion of the lead. (Leading position is between eye and mid-point on horse's neck.)
5. Use the Quarter Method when presenting horse and make eye contact with the judge during inspection.
6. Always be on correct side of the cones.

The Judge will ask 2 questions on horse anatomy and record score.
