



You will need:

- Four Horse shoes, closely matched, used from your horse if possible.
- Assorted photos of you and your horse
- Your first name and your horses name, computer printed on a piece of paper in Tahoma font, size 200, each name can be no longer than 15 inches so if necessary decrease the font size to make it fit.
- Small paintbrush
- All purpose glue or rubber cement

You will be supplied:

- 16-inch square white painted board
- Green paint
- Gold paint
- Rope for hanging stall board



Procedure:

1. Paint horse shoes gold
2. Cut out your and your horses name to make a stencil
3. Pre-assemble your plaque to check the fit. Your name at the top, horseshoes in the middle to make a clover, and the horses name at the bottom. Mark or trace with pencil the names and the shoe locations.
4. Cut photographs to fit into the spaces made by the shoe "clover"
5. Paint the names in with green paint, let dry 5-6 hours
6. Glue pictures onto board, let dry
7. Glue and/or nail horseshoes into place, you will need to place the plaque up on boards to leave space underneath for the nail backs to come through. Bend nails back over on the back of the board. You can cover the nail backs with duct tape for safety.
8. Bring Stall Board to state fair. We will use a rope (provided) to hang from the stall doors.
