NEW REGISTRATION SITE FOR LINCOLN COUNTY LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

Attention Livestock Exhibitors:

Online registration begins May 2, 2022! You will need to visit <http://linmoml.fairwire.com> to complete your market livestock registration for the 2022 Lincoln County Fair. This can be completed between **May 2 and May 31, 2022 before 3 PM.**

- Exhibitors will need to provide the following information to complete registration: name, address, birthdate, parent's name, email address, club name and shirt size. ***Please note that this is the information used to complete the sale bill. Take time to check your spelling, capitalization and punctuation.***
- Each steer, heifer, hog or lamb tagged during the weigh-in process must be registered by the **CORRECT** Lincoln County Fair tag number. Scrapies tags will be required for all lambs. Each animal and tag must be entered on a separate line. All chickens and rabbits planned for the fair must be registered. For example, if you weighed in 3 steers and 4 hogs, you must have a total of 7 animals registered with their corresponding tag and on their **own** line. **Do NOT enter all tag numbers on one animal/line.**
- After all animals have been entered, the exhibitor will then need to purchase the exhibitor pass. If additional passes are needed, they can also be purchased at this time. Passes can be purchased via credit card or PayPal account.

Upon registration completion, you will receive a confirmation receipt indicating the quantity of each species to be exhibited, as well as the number and type of passes purchased.

The Lincoln County Judging & Achievement Day will be held June 24 at Northroad Church. Watch for registration details coming soon.

Montgomery County Judging and Achievement

The Montgomery County Judging and Achievement will take place on June 8 at the United Methodist Church of Montgomery City. Judging & Achievement is a great way to show off the skills of our 4-H members. There are several different events that 4-H members can take part in such as: judging classes, demonstrations, personal development, fashion revue, fashion selection, extemporaneous speaking and public speaking. The judging classes ask you to place items in the best order and be able to tell a judge why you placed them in that way. The demonstrations event is just bringing a demonstration and giving it in front of a judge. Personal development is a great way to start when attending Judging and Achievement. In this event you take a T/F quiz on basic manners and then have a short interview with a judge. Fashion revue and fashion selection are similar events that allow those taking sewing or shopping in style to model their outfits and talk about them to a judge. Extemporaneous speaking is another good event to start with. In this event 4-H members pick a topic and come up with a short talk over the chosen topic. There is no preparation needed for this event. Finally, the Public Speaking event is for 4-Hers to bring a prepared speech that they give the judge. All 4-H members in Montgomery County are encouraged to attend. Ribbons are awarded for all events.

Montgomery County Fair Work Days

4-H members who are participating in the livestock auction at the Montgomery County Fair July 19 to 23 must work four hours for the fair board in order to receive their premium check from the sale of their animal/ham.

There will be two pre-fair work days available this year - Saturday, June 25, and Saturday, July 9. Hours for those Saturdays will be 8 a.m. to noon. Spots will be limited on the two Saturday shifts. Members may also sign up to work a four-hour shift at the soda and food stand Tuesday through Saturday of the fair, 8 a.m. to noon and noon to 4 p.m.
