Montgomery County Fair Livestock Exhibitors

The Montgomery County Fair Board has announced that no livestock entries will be accepted after July 1, 2021. If it is not postmarked by July 1, the entry will not be accepted and the exhibitor will not be allowed to show or sell livestock. There will be no exceptions. Please be sure that you send your entries to the Montgomery County Fair Board, P.O. Box 11, Montgomery City, MO 63361, before July 1.

Livestock vehicle passes will be limited to ONE per family.

Weigh-in will be at 4 p.m. and the exhibitor **MUST BE PRESENT TO WEIGH IN.**

IMPORTANT: Pictures will be taken following the sale of each animal.

The Montgomery County Fair Board requires the Grand Champion and Reserve Champion animals to remain at the fair after the auction for the rest of the fair week. If the exhibitor is showing more than one species and earns Grand or Reserve Champion, their Grand or Reserve Champion animal must be the one species sold at auction (exhibitors who receive Grand or Reserve in more than one species may only choose one animal to sell). Grand and Reserve Champion animals will be released on Saturday, July 23rd at 12:00 p.m. The animals are still the responsibility of the exhibitor all week. The animals will be placed in one barn for the remainder of the week for fairgoers to enjoy.

Those participating in the open shows on Friday/Saturday will NOT be required to remove their animals until after those shows. They will be permitted to keep those animals on the grounds.

No premium or auction proceeds will be paid to any Junior Livestock Exhibitor until: all pens have been cleaned/waste removed and picked up from the livestock building and both the 4-hour Work Certificate and Parking Pass are turned in to the Fair Office. Livestock Chairman will give the official ok to release livestock checks following building inspection.

Montgomery County Fair Work Days

4-H members who are participating in the livestock auction at the Montgomery County Fair July 19 to 23 must work four hours for the fair board in order to receive their premium check from the sale of their animal/ham.

The pre fair workdays are June 25 and July 9 from 8am to noon. There are also shifts during the fair at the Soda/Food Stand. These are at 8am – noon and noon to 4pm. There is also a shift on Monday July 18 from 5pm-9pm.

Montgomery County Fair Parade

All Montgomery County 4-H members and Clovers Kids are invited to ride on the 4-H float in the Montgomery County Fair. 4-Hers can join the float on the fairgrounds by the campground at 6:30 and ride to the parade location. Wear a 4-H t-shirt and dress cool. If you don't have a 4-H shirt wear something green. Parents are responsible for picking their kids up at the campground area immediately after the parade. Be sure to be there when the float returns! Bring water to drink and stay cool!
