1.	Hatching too early with bloody navels	Temperature Too High
2.	Draggy hatch some chicks early, but slow in finishing	Temperature Too High
3.	Delayed hatch Eggs not pipping until 21 st day or later	Temperature Too Low
4.	Short down on chicks	High Temperature Low Humidity
5.	Mushy chicks dead on trays – bad odor	Navel infection Remains in incubator
6.	Chicks too small	Low Humidity High Temperature
7.	Sticky chicks shell sticking to chicks	Eggs dried down too much Low Humidity at hatching time
8.	Sticky chicks chicks smeared with egg contents	Low average temperature Humidity may be too high
9.	Deformed Crippled, missing eye, cross beak, extra leg, etc.	Mostly Chance-Heredity in some cases Temperature
10.	Rough navels	High Temperature Low Humidity
