Good day in 4-H land! ~

Youth Service to Communities (LG760) forms from clubs will be coming due later this season, Sept 30. We just wanted to give you an early heads up, since some of you are asking. (For newer team members, this is an annual report clubs complete of their community service, by which Missouri 4-H tells the story of how young people are learning to lead, work, give back, and be a trusted neighbor through service). Results are shared with key funders like 4-H Foundation, Dept of Ag, and FCS Financial. See 2018 [State Results here](#) and [County Results here](#).

Please ask your club leaders to report their 2018-19 club service results any time between now and end of September! Whether clubs have just one service project to report, or 12, they can receive a 4-H certificate this fall, recognizing their club's participation in service (see details below)! 4-H SPIN clubs are invited to share service results as well.

Two options....

A) Clubs complete LG760 online survey by Sept. 30. This is the fastest and most preferred way. Provide this link to your club leaders: https://missouri.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_6eX1DQhQZMWqNoN. Results come to the state office. You handle nothing, but can access county results and certificate templates for your recognition events.

B) Clubs turn in LG760 PDF form (attached) to your office by Sept. 15. Your office enters their info in LG760 online survey by Sept. 30. The PDF is being added to Club Leader and Forms sections on the web. You keep PDFs for your records, but can still access county results and certificate templates for recognition.

GO FOR THE PURPLE! Clubs and counties reporting service by Sept. 30 can be included in 4-H club service certificate recognition. This is a fun, ongoing incentive to encourage full youth and adult participation in service! Clubs receive a color-seal certificate based on percentage of member/volunteer participation in their service projects:

PURPLE SEAL - 95-100% of members/volunteers involved in club service projects

GOLD SEAL - 75-94% of members/volunteers involved in club service projects

SILVER SEAL - 50-74% of members/volunteers involved in club service projects

GREEN SEAL - 1-49% of members/volunteers involved in club service projects

First Session: 7:30 pm – Friday Final session concludes 3:15 pm – Sunday

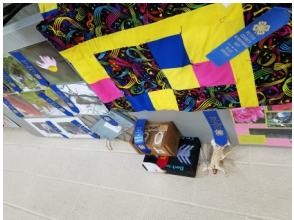
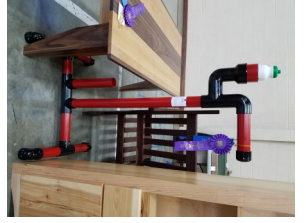
Missouri Shooting Sports State Team Tryout Dates

The selection process for the nine state shooting teams begins this fall after the completion of the state shoot. 4-H youth selected for the state shooting teams will represent Missouri 4-H at the National Invitational Match to be held June 21 - June 26 in Grand Island, Nebraska. Any 4-H Shooting Sports member who is in good standing with their county program, enrolled in the appropriate project number and at least 14 years old (must be 14 years old by December 31, 2019) may participate in the selection process. If numbers and space allows, 13-year-olds may participate for the experience, but are not eligible for the state team. Nearly all of the team selection process is comprised of multiple try out dates. Pre-registration form is required with payment due 2 weeks before first discipline tryout. Telling the state instructor does not qualify for pre-registration. Contact Jim Sappington with questions.

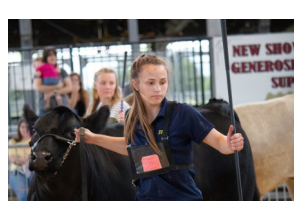
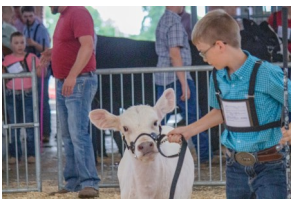
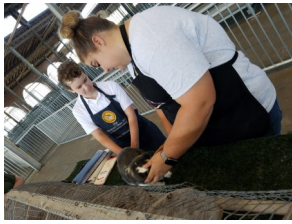




Pettis County Jr. Livestock Show and Sale
