# Standards for 4-H Seals

## Purpose of Standards and Seals

### **To Encourage:**

A quality educational program for members.

All youth to participate.

Clubs to include a variety of educational programs and activities.

### **To Provide:**

Appropriate recognition for single-project clubs, multi-project clubs or special interest groups.

## **Bronze Seal**

1. Five or more members.
2. Necessary leadership and parent involvement.
3. Four or more meetings or a minimum of six hours teaching time. Including demonstrations or judging in the club program.
4. At least one project group.
5. Enrollment records on file at the University Extension Center.
6. Sixty percent or more of members complete at least one project.

## **Silver Seal**

1. Eight or more members.
2. Necessary officers.
3. Necessary leadership and parent involvement.
4. Eight or more club meetings.
5. At least one project group.
6. An average of five project meetings or an average of six hours teaching time for all projects carried by the club.
7. A planned program, which includes demonstrations or judging, health or safety, and recreation.
8. A local achievement program or participation in a county achievement program.
9. Participation of leaders in council meetings and leader training.
10. Achieve two or more goals in the club's planned program.
11. Enrollment records on file at the University Extension Center.
12. Sixty-five percent or more of members complete at least one project.

## **Gold Seal**

1. Ten or more members.
2. A full set of officers.
3. Necessary leadership and parent involvement.
4. Ten or more meetings.
5. At least one project group.
6. An average of five project meetings or an average of six hours teaching time for all projects carried by the club.
7. A planned program, which includes demonstrations or judging, health or safety, recreation, and another 4-H activity.
8. Achieve one or more goals in recreation, health, safety, and an additional 4-H activity.
9. A local achievement program or participation in a county achievement program.
10. Participation of leaders in council meetings and leader training.
11. Enrollment records on file at the University Extension Center.
12. Seventy percent or more of members complete at least one project and reach their project goals in that project.
