## **4-H TEEN LEADER**

The major purpose of the Teen Leader Program is to provide you with the opportunity to make a contribution to your community by assuming an adult leadership role and develop your own humanitarian attitudes and leadership skills.

### **PREREQUISITES FOR BEING A TEEN LEADER:**

- A. Be 16-19 years of age as of January 1 of program year.
- B. Enrolled in 273 – Step Up to Leadership Level 3

### **REQUIREMENTS OF TEEN LEADERSHIP:**

- A. Assume full leadership responsibility for teaching a group of younger members, aged 8-12 years old, in a 4-H club or project group. Recruit and organize them into a group and perform as their teacher. The recommended size of the group is not less than 5 or more than 10. You may recruit an additional Teen Leader in a “buddy” system to assist with the teaching and recruiting efforts.
- B. An adult advisor is not required. If you want help, you may seek the counsel of other adults.
- C. Submit your completed “Teen Teaching Plan” to your club leader for approval.
- D. Enrollment – By January 1, submit the written “Teen Teaching Plan” to the Extension Office. Your plan will be approved or returned for revisions.
- E. Carry out plans, making adjustments and additions where needed.
- F. Teach at least (6) six lessons and file necessary reports.
- G. Attend training meetings designed for Teen Leaders.
- H. Completion – By September 1, re-submit your “Teen Teaching Plan” to the Extension Office, signed by your club leader, certifying your accomplishments. **To receive credit and a teen leader pin and certificate, this step must be completed.**
