# How do I find funding opportunities?



Pivot is a large database of federal and private funding opportunities and an expertise database to help you identify potential collaborators within MU. In Pivot, you can conduct a search to get current funding opportunities and save that search so that you receive weekly alerts as new funding opportunities are added. Pivot is a subscription service provided free of charge to all faculty and staff by the MU Office of Research.

#### How to access?

- 1. Start by visiting pivot.proquest.com
- 2. Create an account by clicking Sign Up and then Use Email Address/Create Password
- 3. Enter your university email account, along with basic personal information, and be sure to choose University of Missouri—Columbia as Affiliated Member Institution

#### Search tips:

- ✓ Use "Advanced Search"
- ✓ Type in "Missouri" for the "Activity Location"
- ✓ Type in "United States" for "Citizenship or Residency "
- ✓ Use the "Keyword" area to search for and select relevant key words



Foundation Directory Online provides a searchable database of 156,000+ U.S. foundations. Foundation Directory Online allows users to search by keyword and geography. Foundation Directory Online is a subscription service provided free of charge to all faculty and staff by MU Advancement, Office of Foundation Relations.

### How to access?

- 1. You gain entry to the directory through your IP address; you do not create your own account.
- 2. If you are in a campus office, go to the <u>MU Office of Sponsored Programs Administration</u> and click on "Go to Foundation Directory Online" at the bottom of the page.
- 3. If you are off campus, first connect to MU via VPN using the \*employee profile. Once connected, go to the MU Office of Sponsored Programs Administration and click on "Go to Foundation Directory Online" at the bottom of the page.

- ✓ Use "Advanced Search"
- ✓ Search by County in "Geographic Focus"
- ✓ Type in relevant search terms in "Subject Area"

- ✓ Check foundation opportunities at **Philanthropy News Digest**. Browse the list and sign up for the newsletter here.
- ✓ Sign up for newsletters from federal agencies that are relevant to your work, such as the following:
