Steps for Safe Operations

Farms are essential businesses



Have everyone wash hands when entering farm and before leaving farm.




Clean and sanitize tables and picking materials after each use. Disinfect all surfaces touched by anyone — you, workers, customers.



Wear gloves when handling payment.




CDC recommends wearing cloth face coverings or nonsurgical masks in public.



Don't open the farm if you are sick.

- Sick workers should stay home.
- Communicate with customers to stay home if they are sick or have recently been sick.
- Before picking season, inform customers of the guidelines for coming to the farm.



Set up extra hand-washing stations across the farm.
