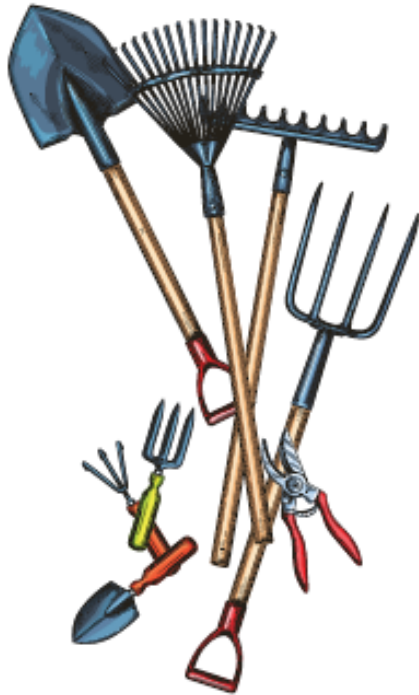


COVID-19: Landscape Maintenance Worker Safety

Landscape maintenance is essential business



Sanitize tool handles and equipment.



Wash your hands regularly.

Off-site safety

Stay home if you are sick.

- Wear a mask when riding in a vehicle with others. Make sure the vehicle is well ventilated.
- Sanitize commonly touched surfaces — steering wheels; time cards; tool handles; door handles; equipment handles, grips and knobs; gear shifts; pull cord handles; etc.
- Wash your hands regularly.
- Wash or replace gloves as necessary.

On-site safety

Protect your customers, yourself and your crew: Stay outside.

- Wear gloves when handling gate latches, door knobs, lawn and patio furniture, and other amenities.
- Remove and dispose of all personal items — tissues, rags, gloves, food wrappers, beverage containers — off-site.
- Practice zero-contact transactions. Use new disposable gloves if available, and wash or sanitize hands after handling cash, checks or cards.
