Financially Coping with Covid-19

The federal government is creating programs that seek to help people and businesses throughout America. Because the programs are so big, there are a lot of moving parts and different places to find information. This handout provides information for one of the many personal assistance programs and where you can go to find information from an official government source.



What is it?

The Federal and Missouri state governments are changing the due dates for income tax filing and tax payments from April 15 to July 15, 2020.



Who is eligible?

All taxpayers.



What do I need to do?

Nothing if you plan to file before July 15, 2020.

If July 15 is too soon for you to file, you can file [form 4868](#) to extend the filing deadline to October 15, 2020. If July is too soon for you to pay your taxes owed, you need to arrange a payment plan to pay your taxes over time, beyond July 15, 2020.
