Missouri State Ambassadors Code of Conduct

Missouri State Ambassadors members are "high profile" representative of Missouri 4-H program. Everything you do during your term reflects on 4-H. The name and reputation of 4-H is so valuable, is why the Code of Conduct reflects the standards, guidelines and expectations of all 4-H Ambassadors.

As a State 4-H Ambassador, I will...

- 1. obey the laws of my community, state and country, and I accept responsibility for knowing them.
- stay 100% free from drugs, including both consuming drugs and being in possession of them. This includes alcohol, tobacco products in all forms (chewing, cigarettes, ecigarettes, etc), and marijuana. I will not stay in the presence of others who are using drugs.
- 3. attend the weekend meetings, assist with the Missouri State Fair, present workshops, presentations or other needed assistance in the region.
 - If I cannot attend an event, I will provide the State Ambassador Coordinator appropriate documentation at least two weeks before the event or meeting.
 - If I miss more than one meeting during the year without an approved absence, I will meet with Coordinator about continuing in my role.
 - Late arrivals or early departures must also be approved by the Ambassador Coordinator.
- 4. take responsibility for my choices and accept the consequences of my actions. I know that I can be dismissed from the Missouri Ambassador Program immediately if I fail to uphold the first three expectations above.
- 5. work cooperatively and respectfully with the youth, adult staff, 4-H volunteers, and University of Missouri employees.
- 6. be trustworthy and reliable in carrying out responsibilities I've accepted.
- 7. look out for safety and well-being of others, and act quickly to report anything which threatens it.

- 8. accept that I am a role model and use the etiquette expected of a Missouri Ambassador team member, including:
 - Abstaining from any public displays of affection that are inappropriate for the setting
 - Dressing respectfully and in a way that's appropriate for the task at hand
 - Keeping language appropriate to the environments I'm in and avoiding profanity
 - Posting to all social media sites
 - Showing up on time or early to 4-H meeting and events
- 9. use my best judgement because I also understand that not all things that are inappropriate are written in this code of conduct.
