Suggested Age: 8-13

Reasons:

D is first because it is actual cake decorating coloring. It will mix through the icing evenly and easily.

A is second because it is still cake decorating coloring, but it is spray on, which the color of the icing will not be evenly the same. And it would take a little longer to color it.

C is third because it is still cake decorating coloring, but they are markers, which would take a very long time to color the whole cake and the color would not be evenly the same.

B is last because it is food coloring and it is not made for icing. Even though if need be it would work. But it would take a lot of coloring to get it the same color throughout.
