### Service-Learning Workshop Activity 2

Print the following pages for use with Activity 2. For this activity, you will need five volunteers to read a short description of each step. Ask the members to place the service-learning steps in the order they think they occur. Ask why they chose that order or sequence. Have the youth move the cards into a circle. Help them see that service-learning is not a linear (or one-and-done) process, but it is circular or cyclical (or keeps on going). Reflection and communicate/celebrate steps can leads back into investigate, and the process stars over. Apply this to whether a 4-H club does the same project year-to-year, or different projects that impact the same community or issue (stream cleanup). The key is provided below.
