- **Investigate**
 - Identify and deepen your understanding of a community issue or cause
- **Prepare & Plan**
 - Set an educational goal for what you want to learn and how you will determine your success
 - SMART Goal
 - Identify community partners, organize a plan of action, clarify roles, and build timelines
- **Act**
 - Work as a team to implement your action plan
- **Reflect**
 - Explore your thoughts and feelings about the project during the process and when you are finished
- **Communicate & Celebrate**
 - Capture what you have learned, the steps you have taken, and the impact of your projects
 - Share your story to further educate and inform the community
 - Celebrate your accomplishments
