Apron Fabric

Supplies Needed:

Photos of items or real items, Situation and Option card, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart and pencils.

Reasons:

D is over **A** because the fabric of **D** is heavy, firm, strong woven and dark color. **A** is a good, strong fabric, but the light color will soil and stain easily.

A is over **C** because the fabric of **A** will be much stronger than **C** and less likely to tear. The print fabric of **C** would not show dirt but would not wear will either.

C is over **B** because while lightweight, the fabric of **C** would have some durability and wear.

B is last because it would stretch and loose shape.
