Supplies Needed:

Photos of items or real items, Situation and Option card, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart, and pencils.

Reasons:

- A is over **B** because hay is more insulating and warmer than straw and stays in place better
- **B** is over **C** because **B** will not absorb dampness as easily and can be added to often. Also blankets can be pulled out of doghouse by dog
- C is over D because a blanket is soft as well as warm; newspaper is not. Granted, that blankets can be shredded by the dog chewing on it and if eaten can cause intestinal blockage
- D is last because paper is not insulating, will not stay in place and disintegrates when wet.
