Supplies Needed:

Photos of items or real items, Situation and Option card, 4-H judging cards, Judging Scale Chart, and pencils

Reasons: D, C, A, B

D is over **C** because the chew bone is a product specially designed for that specific purpose, and would probably crumble and cover affect more surface area than the dried pig ear.

C is over **A** because the dog will have a more natural chewing instinct with the dried pig ear and will be more likely to chew on it on his own.

A is over **B** because the rope toy is much safer for the dog. A chicken bone should never be give to a dog for a chew; it may break into fine, needle-like pieces and lodge in your dog's mouth and throat.
