

Skill-a-Thon Horticulture –Garden Planning a Garden

Supplies Needed

Pictures of different fruits and vegetables, paper, pen or flash cards

Situation

You are preparing to plan for your garden. You need to make sure each plant has the proper amount of space to grow. You need to know how the plant produces the fruit or vegetable.

Task

Identify different fruits and vegetables to tell if they grow on vines, underground, above ground or on a tree.

Directions

Look at pictures of various fruits and vegetables.

Write on the piece of paper the name of the fruit or vegetable and whether it grows on vines, underground, or above ground.
