What do you need to bring?

- Photo Identification for you and your spouse (if applicable)
- Social security cards for every person listed on the return
- W-2s for every job worked
- Routing and account number for direct deposit if desired
- The amount of any stimulus received or not received
- 2019 tax return (optional, but helpful)

- 1099-Interest
- 1099-Dividends
- 1099-R Retirement income
- 1098 Mortgage interest
- 1099-NEC Nonemployee compensation
- 1099-MISC Other income
- 1098-E Student loan interest
- 1098-T Tuition and your account statement
- 1099-G Unemployment
- 1099-G State refund
- 1099-B Broker exchange
- SSA 1099 Social Security income
- 1095-A Marketplace Statement
- W-2G Gambling income
- Form 5674 Verification of Rent Paid, signed by your landlord
- Real estate and personal property tax receipt
- Childcare expenses and the name, address, and tax ID of the provider
- Identity Protection PIN from the IRS for everyone who has one in your family
