The 2010 Affordable Care Act, often referred to as Obamacare, was the most sweeping health-policy change since Medicare was established in 1965. Because the law significantly changed health insurance rules, Missouri consumers needed resources to help make informed decisions. University of Missouri Extension, through our Health Insurance Education Initiative (HIEI), responded statewide with a politically neutral program to help Missourians understand how the law affected them. To date, extension faculty have held more than 400 HIEI public presentations across the state for individuals, families and employers. They also shared information with Missourians though educational and outreach activities in local communities.
