

2022 MU Commercial Pesticide Recertification and Retraining Program

Please read this entire brochure before completing registration.

This program is for Certified Commercial, Noncommercial and Public Pesticide Applicator Recertification and for Licensed Pesticide Technician - Retraining*

General Information

The 2022 training will be delivered online as a fully virtual conference. You will register for one full day of training which will include the CORE and category specific training in which you do the majority of your work.

To attend this training, participants must have a valid individual email address and be able to participate online on a computer with the ability to view and hear video. If you are unable to participate in this virtual training, please contact the Missouri Department of Agriculture for recertification alternatives.

*PESTICIDE TECHNICIAN RETRAINING – LICENSED TECHNICIANS – The Missouri Pesticide Use Act Section (2 CSR 70-25.156) requires all licensed pesticide technicians to participate in additional training within THREE YEARS from initial licensure and within each subsequent three-year period. Participation in RECERTIFICATION training will meet the requirements for pesticide technician retraining.

All recertification and retraining programs will be held during the dates offered below. To allow flexibility in scheduling, each category will be offered at least twice. You are registering for a full day of training. Your participation in recertification/retraining in the core and category session in which you do the MAJORITY of your work will serve for recertification/retraining in all categories in which you are currently licensed

Daily Schedule: Core Training 8:00 am – 12:00 pm;
Category Training 1:00 – 4:00 pm.

Credit will NOT be approved for persons who log in late, do not register for the program, or do not attend the entire program, both CORE and category sessions. Please plan your day accordingly. Attendance will be tracked within the Attendee Hub.

VIRTUAL EVENT ACCESS

At least 36 hours prior to the event, registered attendees will receive an email with log-in information to the Attendee Hub. This email will be sent to the email address on file with your individual registration. The email address is tied to the attendee, so it is important that the email address is accessible and designated to that specific individual as only one email address can be used per person. The Attendee Hub will provide access through an internet browser which will allow registered attendees to view the live stream, session detail information and speaker handouts. Each attendee needs access to log in and view the session on an individual internet enabled device.

For the best viewing experience, we recommend using the following browsers: Edge, Chrome, Firefox and Safari. For attendees viewing on Internet Explorer 11, you may experience lags in streaming.

Credit will NOT be approved for persons who log in late, do not register for the program, or do not attend the entire program, both CORE and category sessions. Please plan your day accordingly. Attendance will be tracked within the hub. Brief lapses in internet connectivity and a dropped signal will not impact recertification, as long as the attendee reconnects as soon as possible.

RECERTIFICATION/RETRAINING

Applicators and Technicians certified and licensed in more than one category may recertify or retrain in those categories by attending recertification training for the category in which they do the most work. You may receive training in only one category each day (with the exception of 7a & 7b which are taught as one category). If you wish to attend training in additional categories, you must attend additional dates. A fee is required for each date.

If you are a pesticide applicator holding MULTIPLE licenses (e.g. Commercial/Technician) with each license reflecting certification and licensure in different categories, you WILL be required to attend an approved recertification program for each license and related categories prior to the Recertified Until Expiration Date or Retrained Until Expiration Date printed on the license.

e.g. – Applicator holds a Commercial Applicator license in Category 3 – Ornamental and Turf Pest Control, Recertified Until May 31, 2022 and a Pesticide Technician license in Category 7A – General Structural Pest Control, Retrained Until April 30, 2022, you must attend an approved recertification program for both categories for recertification or retraining credit).

REGISTRATION

The registration fee will be \$75.00 for the day of recertification training, which includes core and category specific training. Pre-registration is recommended in order to ensure receipt of log-in information.

Online registration at pat.missouri.edu is the preferred method of registration. If mail in registration is required to process payment via check, please complete attached registration form. Please note that all confirmations and receipts will be emailed to the email address associated with the registration.
